TALL FESCUE MERIDA

- Midnight type.
- Maximum grass density and quality.
- Excellent resistance to trampling.
- Tolerates mowing down to 10 mm.
- Less prone to thatch.
- Combines dark color and good shade resistance.
- Highest drought resistance.
- Its rapid lateral growth prevents the appearance of weeds.
- Cold resistant with good winter growth.
- Ideal for mixing with other tall fescues, blue grasses and perenne ryegrass.
- Excellent for intense usage (landscape, rough, reclamation).

INSTALLATION AND MAINTENANCE

- Sow preferably in spring or fall, burying the seed superficially (5mm).
- Water lightly and regularly until the plant is established.
- Does not require fungicides but must be monitored for Brown Patch in summer.
- Fertilize in a balanced way (1:1:1).
- Once established, water thoroughly and in a spaced-out manner.
- Accepts growth regulators well.
